### Why does financial stability matter?

Almost three-quarter of respondents (70 percent) to the United Way of York County's 2015 Community Needs Assessment overwhelmingly identified "good paying jobs" as a "high need."

The living wage for a family of three (i.e., one working parent and two children) in York County is \$25.78 an hour.

Children not raised in poverty enter school prepared to learn, have better behavioral and physical health, are less likely to engage with juvenile justice, and experience less hunger.
