Applicants seeking funding must demonstrate their ability to track common standard performance measures demonstrating their alignment with UWYC's mission, focus, and priority areas. The following Performance Measures will answer three questions regarding your program: 1) How much did you do? 2) How well did you do it? and 3) Is anyone better off?

- # of participants who are actively engaged in case management
- # of clients who were referred to other providers/programs
- # of clients engaged in identifying / establishing personal goals and are taking steps towards achieving those goals
- # of clients who successfully completed their program goals
- # of clients who are consistently able to pay their bills on time
- # of clients who are earning at the self-sufficiency standard for their family size.
- # of clients who costs for supportive services was reduced
- # of clients who received incentives or support to overcome barriers
