

## TARGET POPULATION GUIDELINES 2022-2023

All programs funded by UWYC's Financial Stability initiative must include at least one of the following: Individuals who are unemployed, underemployed, earning up to 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, or not earning income at the Self Sufficiency Standard for family size, along with single female heads of household.
